(Quraish) CVI**

*In the Name of Allâh
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.*

1. (It is a great Grace and Protection from Allâh) for the taming of the Quraish,

2. (And with all those Allâh's Grace and Protections for their taming, We cause) the (Quraish) caravans to set forth safe in winter (to the south) and in summer (to the north) without any fear,

3. So let them worship (Allâh) the Lord of this House (the Ka'bah in Makkah),

4. (He) Who has fed them against hunger, and has made them safe from fear.

(The Small Kindnesses) CVII**

*In the Name of Allâh
the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.*

1. Have you seen him who denies the Recompense?

2. That is he who repulses the orphan (harshly),^[1]

3. And urges not on the feeding of Al-Miskîn (the poor),^[2]

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

أَرَأَيْتَ الَّذِي يُكَذِّبُ بِالْإِيمَانِ ①

فَذَلِكَ الَّذِي يَدْعُ الْيَتِيمَ ②

وَلَا يَحْضُ عَلَى طَعَامِ الْمِسْكِينِ ③

they reached valley Muhassir. While the army was marching towards Makkah, in the middle of the valley, suddenly it was overtaken by flocks of birds, flocks after flocks, air-raiding that army with small stones slightly bigger than a lentil seed. There never fell a stone on a soldier except it dissolved his flesh and burst it into pieces. So they perished with a total destruction. Abrahah Al-Ashram fled away while his flesh was bursting into pieces till he died on the way (back to Yemen). Such was the victory bestowed by Allâh, (the All-Majestic, All-Powerful) to the people of Makkah and such was the protection provided by Him for His House (Ka'bah in Makkah).
